

Accessibility to Craiglinnhe House

Whilst we aim to meet the needs of all our guests there are some period features which could make access difficult for those with limited mobility. However we do try to make Craiglinnhe House as accessible as we can so please contact us to discuss your individual needs.

Access to the main house

The entrance to the guest house has flat level access from our car park with two steps in through the front door.

Entrance door widths:

Outer door - 42" (107 cm)

Inner door - 38" (97cm)

Access to the rooms

Craiglinnhe House does not have ground floor bedrooms, toilet facilities or a lift/elevator so is not suitable for guests who require the sole use of a wheelchair.

Within the guest house there are 12 steps to the first landing with an additional 3 steps to room 5. Another 6 steps allow access to rooms 1, 2, 3 and four.

Room information

All room door widths are a standard 31" (79cm)

Bed heights from floor to top of mattress:

Room 1 – 31" (79cm) – kingsize bed

Room 2 – 27" (69cm) – single bed x 2

Room 3 – 30" (76cm) – superkingsize (or split into 2 singles)

Room 4 – 22" (56cm) – standard double

Room 5 – 22" (56cm) – standard double

We do not have wet rooms and each of our en-suite showers are enclosed in a screened cubicle, each is accessed by a small step, room 4 has the largest cubicle at 38" x 30" (97x76cm). Please discuss us if you would like further information on shower cubicle sizes. None of our showers currently have grab rails.

Please kindly note the following:

- Fire alarm is audible only but please be assured that additional assistance will be given in the event of an emergency
- Assistance with luggage is always offered
